FOR YOUNG SCHOLARS

PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

In order to support a peaceful and safe school environment KinderAcademy does not tolerate:

- Disruptive behavior which interferes or threatens to interfere with any of the schools normal operation or activities anywhere on the school premises.
- Using loud or offensive language or displaying temper.
- Threatening in any way, a member of staff, visitor, fellow parent/guardian or child.
- · Damaging or destroying school property.
- Sending abusive or threatening emails or text/voicemail/phone messages or other written communications (including social media) to anyone within the school community.
- Gossip and public criticism which are malicious in nature are unacceptable.
- Defamatory, offensive or derogatory comments regarding the school or any of the children/parents/staff at the school on Facebook or other social media sites
- Verbal/physical attacks (hitting, fighting) on other children and/or Staff, which include the use of threats, name-calling, as well as repeated profane or degrading language. Individuals engaging in such behavior will be asked to leave the premises immediately. This includes physical punishment of your own child on school premises.
- Approaching someone else's child in order to discuss or chastise them because of the actions of this child towards their own child. (Such an approach to a child may be seen to be an assault on that child and may have legal consequences)
- Smoking, taking illegal drugs or the consumption of alcohol on school premises. (Alcohol may only be consumed during authorized events)
- No weapons are allowed on the property or at Events/ functions.
- Theft of personal or KinderAcademy property.

Should any of the above occur on school premises or in connection with school the school may feel it is necessary to take action by contacting the appropriate authorities or consider banning the offending adult from entering the school premises.
